

VCAO Checklist: CRIME FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The following is an eligibility checklist to qualify victims of **CRIME** for emergency funding through the VCAO Program. If the client does not meet the eligibility standards outlined in the following document, they are not eligible for funding through this program, but **MAY** be eligible for other services provided by SAVCARS.

FUNDING RESOURCES AVAILABLE: IF QUALIFIED

Up to \$1,000 for Emergency Meals, Accommodations, Transportation, Home Safety Repairs
Up to \$5,000 for Funeral Expenses
Up to \$1,000 for Counselling and Transportation to Counselling
Up to \$1,500 for Crime Scene Clean Up (involving bodily fluids)

Referring agency must be prepared to provide SAVCARS Staff with the victims Personal Information, and Information about the Crime. Consent from the victim is required

Arrangements will be made by our agency to have the victim sign the funding application forms for approval. SAVCARS Staff will complete all corresponding paperwork.
